
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RETENTION OF COUNSEL TO FILE AND PROSECUTE A CLAIM AND/OR ACTION AGAINST EDWARD SCOTT MCKENZIE AND S.E.M. A MINOR, FOR DAMAGE TO THE FENCE AT BAYVIEW PARK.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Mulga, Alabama, while in regular session on Tuesday, January 17, 2023, at 6:30 p.m. as follows:


A. That the Town Attorney is hereby authorized to represent the interests of the Town of Mulga, Alabama, a municipal corporation ("the Town"), in pursuing a claim and/or filing suit against Edward Scott McKenzie and S.E.M., a minor, and/or responsible parties related to damage to the fence at Bayview Park, including, but not limited to those who may have owned or negligently entrusted or supervised the minor with the vehicle involved in the incident or otherwise responsible for the conduct of the minor or otherwise responsible for the vehicle; to associate such other counsel as may be required to represent the interests of the Town; and to take any and all actions necessary to advance the interests of the Town in relation to the matters described herein, including all stages of litigation, discovery, trial, and appeal; and

B. That the Mayor and other officers and employees of the Town acting under the direction of the Mayor are hereby authorized to execute any claim forms, pleadings, engagement agreements, waivers, or other documents that may be necessary to preserve the Town's interests relative to the matters described herein.


