District 4: They are doing some great things at the concession stand.

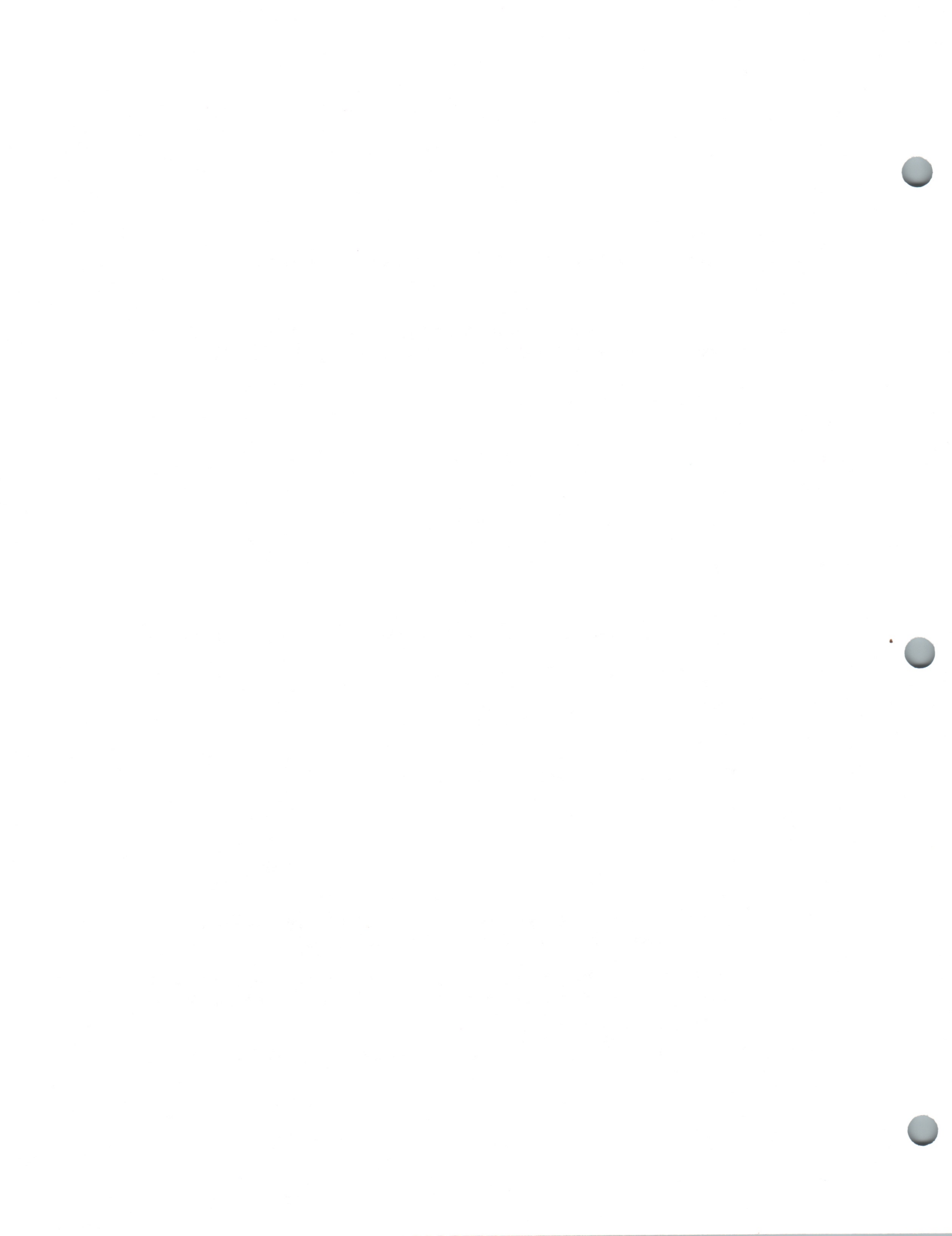
Mayor: The new vent worked well.

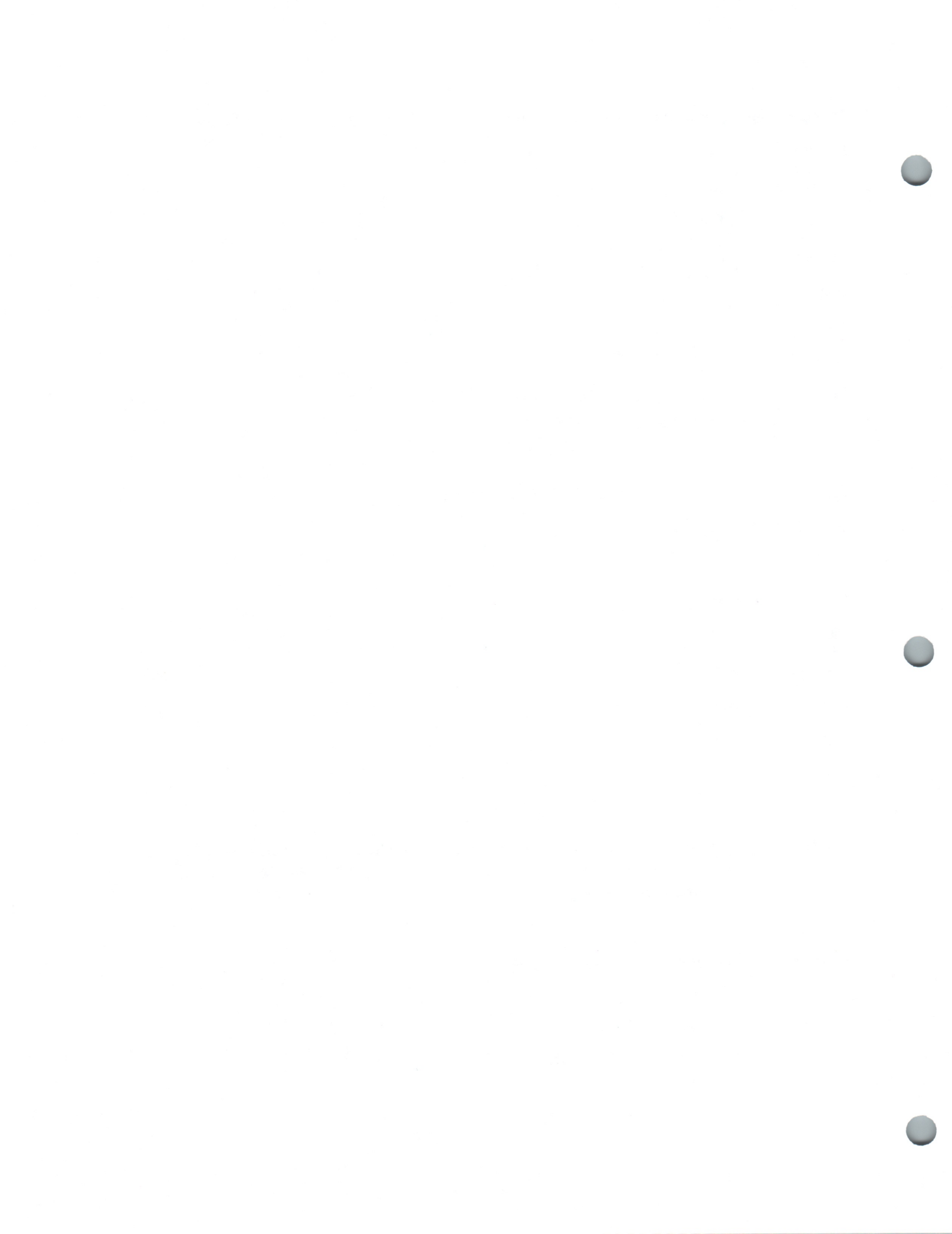
