A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RETENTION OF COUNSEL TO FILE SUIT FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF TO PREVENT THE HARASSMENT OF TOWN EMPLOYEES AND DISRUPTION OF GOVERNMENT SERVICES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Mulga, Alabama, while in a special called meeting on Thursday, September 14, 2023, at 4:30 p.m. as follows:

- A. That the Town Attorney is hereby authorized to represent the interests of the Town of Mulga, Alabama, a municipal corporation, and its Water & Gas Department (collectively "the Town") in filing suit for injunctive relief against responsible parties related to the harassment of Town employees in their line of duty and disruption of government operations; to associate such other counsel as may be required to represent the interests of the Town; and to take any and all actions necessary to advance the interests of the Town in relation to the matters described herein, including all stages of litigation, discovery, trial, and appeal; and
- B. That the Mayor and other officers and employees of the Town acting under the direction of the Mayor are hereby authorized to execute any claim forms, pleadings, engagement agreements, waivers, or other documents that may be necessary to preserve the Town's interests relative to the matters described herein.
