## TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MULGA, ALABAMA

## ORDINANCE NO. 2024-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MULGA, ALABAMA, TO DETERMINE THAT TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERS SHALL BE ELECTED AT LARGE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mulga, Alabama ("the Town") desires to take certain actions with respect to its next municipal election, which shall have its election day on August 26, 2025, and for which newly elected municipal officials shall take office on November 3, 2025;

WHEREAS, the Town has a population of less than 12,000 inhabitants according to the last federal census;

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Town Council of the Town of Mulga, Alabama, while in regular session on Tuesday, November 19, 2024, at 6:30 p.m., as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 11-43-2(d) of the *Code of Alabama* (1975), the Town Council Members to be elected in the next municipal election shall be elected by the Town at large.

<u>Section 2.</u> The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any of these sections, provisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or parts is held to be unconstitutional or void, the remainder shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication as required by law.
