District 1: 121 Front Street is still very messy.

Was contact made with the owners of the overgrown properties on Mulga Loop Rd?

Mayor: Letters were sent to both addresses. The owner of one of the properties is deceased. We haven't heard anything from the other.

District 1: 305 Walnut St has a swimming pool with growth in it and the yard is overgrown. 124 4th Ave also needs a letter sent them.

District 2: Nothing

District 3: The block party is this Saturday. We are wearing our gray shirts. Did we get an extension for the demolition of 204 Forest Ave?

Mayor: Yes, we did.

District 3: The yard got cut and looks good at 206 Forest Ave. Have we resolved the Andy McCaleb request?

Mayor: We agreed to pay half of the original service call amount.

District 4: What is going on with the American flag at the walking track?

Mayor: The rope was frayed. We are waiting to get the bucket truck back to put it back up.

District 4: Is the new business still interested in coming here?

Mayor: I've talked to him a couple of times but haven't heard anything lately. I will reach out to him next week.

District 4: I suggest that the new dumpsters be placed pointing towards Bayview Drive.

Mayor: We are going to rethink how it is laid out down there.

District 1: I think if we aren't using the dumpsters, we could rent them out.

District 3: Are we changing the schedule that the dumpsters will be open?

Mayor: I suggest that we keep the same schedule and possibly add some other days.

District 4: We might need to have a sign that says not for commercial use.

District 3: If they dump something that they shouldn't, are we going to charge a fee for that?

Mayor: Yes, we would do that.

Mayor: I received a call from the Post Office bragging on our guys when they didn't hesitate to jump in and help during a situation that happened on 1st Ave.

District 5: Nothing

Mayor: The transmission for the bucket truck will be here in 3-4 weeks.

The Fire Dept. got the grant that they applied for to do the interior of the fire station on Woodland.

The Fire Dept. also got a Mercedes ambulance donated to them to be used as a rehab unit.

I asked what it would cost to put it into service and possibly go into a contract with Sylvan Springs and Maytown. It would need to be self-sustainable. This is very preliminary.

Mayor: I have received a quote of \$18,125.00 for a 60X20 lean-to pole barn that would be placed in the laydown yard. That price includes labor, materials & everything.

Everything is on target for the block party. I have reached out to the Post Office so that they are aware that we will have the roads blocked off.

Lelan Taylor makes a motion to approve up to \$18,000 for the repair of the bucket truck. Seconded by Lisa Armstrong. Roll call vote:


