District 5: The house across from Bayview Baptist has several abandoned cars in the roadway.

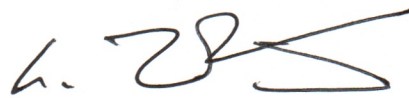
Rachel Davis makes a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Lisa Armstrong. All in favor.
